56 children with Autism received one-on-one swim lessons to help turn the dangers associated with water to an opportunity for success and accomplishment!

33,830 trips (over 285,000 kilometers) were made for **1,000** people in Pictou County to help increase their access to programs and services in our community.



Over **150** therapeutic hours were provided to over **65** families for issues such as grief, parenting, communication, anxiety, and adjusting to new family situations.

95 families with children with varying abilities participated in inclusive, active, fun, and social events.



HIGHLAND COMMUNITY RESIDENTIAL SERVICES



112 families had access to **39** different programs that address food security, health relationships, healthy development, readiness to learn, physical health, relations and social supports

Over **8,000** vulnerable people had access to fresh vegetables grown in the Community Garden.

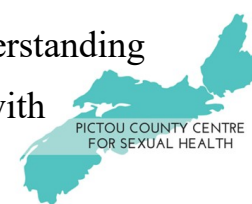

Over **1,260** calls from Pictou County for help on services such as housing, mental health/addictions, income support/financial assistance, individual/family services, and food/meals.

Safer Spaces Training was presented to over **80** community members to raise awareness and understanding of the LGBTQ2 community. Provided **20** individuals living with mental illnesses and disorders with programming that strengthened their coping abilities.



A nutritious breakfast was served to over **40** students enabling them to focus on their school work and not on their empty stomachs - in many cases, the only nutritious meal of the day.

Over **2,000** seniors received support in times of crisis and assistance in the navigation of health and wellness resources.



Helped **20** local young people end their homelessness, provided youth of Pictou County with **340** nights of accommodation, and served over **500** meals to youth ages 16-24.

150 youth had access to the fitness centre, gymnasium, youth leadership activities, and high school drop-in program; increasing youth engagement in our community.
